The federal government has established regulations governing two situations that affect a student's ability to continue receiving Federal Title IV funding (grants, loans, and work study) based on **semester hours attempted**. One of these regulations, "<u>maximum time frame</u>," states that students can receive funding through 150% of the published number of credits in their current program of study. Once a student reaches the 150% cutoff, no additional Title IV aid can be awarded unless the financial aid director approves an exception. This includes if you have completed a previous program and are wanting to pursue a different program.

The second regulation, "pace," relates to maximum time frame. The pace provision states that students must be able to complete their current program of study by the time they have reached their maximum time frame cutoff. If the financial aid director determines that this is not mathematically possible at the time the student's status is reviewed, no Title IV aid can be awarded from that point forward unless the director approves an exception.

As of this date, you are either (a) at maximum time frame or (b) not on pace to complete your program of study before reaching maximum time frame.

If you wish to be considered for federal financial aid, please use the **back side** of this form to provide an explanation of why your maximum time frame should be extended. **Be specific.** Consider extenuating circumstances such as medical problems, significant personal problems, or prior coursework that doesn't apply toward your current major or has become outdated. Also indicate if you have earned a prior degree. If you are pursuing a new program, include why the first program was not sufficient and why a second program is needed.

Please note: Some health programs require pre-admission requirements before being formally accepted to that program. You must be admitted to that health program <u>first</u> before your petition will be reviewed.
